 and fifty one between James Morris of the County of
 Murray of the one part and Jacob Hedrick of the County of
 State of Georgia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said James Morris
 for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him
 in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these pre-
 sents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained
 sold delivered conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell deliver convey and confirm unto the said Jacob Hedrick his heirs
 and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being
 in the tenth district of the third section of Original Cherokee
 town Murray County in said State which said tract or parcel of land
 is known and distinguished in the original plan of said
 district by the number eighty seven (87) containing one hundred
 and sixty acres more or less having such shape form and width
 as appears from the plat and Survey for the same. It has and to
 hold said tract or parcels of land with all and singular tenements
 members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said John
 Johnson and persons being (belonging) or in any manner appertaining unto the
