

# *Descendants of Ann Headrick*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. ANN<sup>1</sup> HEADRICK (*JACOB<sup>A</sup>*)<sup>1,2</sup> was born Abt. 1830 in Tennessee, and died Aft. 1870 in ? (See notes) ?<sup>3</sup>. She married JEREMIAH CROWSON<sup>4,5,6,7</sup> Bef. 1846. He was born 1823 in Tennessee<sup>8,9,10</sup>, and died Bet. 1866 - 1923.

### Notes for ANN HEADRICK:

Ann Headrick Crowson did not sign the 1866 property deed for division of Jacob and Polly Headrick's land. Her husband, Jeremiah, did. However, the census of 1870 shows that Ann was still living. The deed was not recorded until 1870, so Ann may have been deceased by then. It might help to look at Georgia property and inheritance laws of 1870, and find out what the guidelines were for transference of inherited property (who could sign, etc.) This suggested line of research is not based on any question of the propriety or impropriety of Jeremiah's signing of the deed, but is a clue in giving us a better range of death for Ann (Headrick) Crowson. The death range now, based on the documentation available, is between 1870 (date of last census documentation) to 1935 (date of reaching 105); with a clue of looking at 1870, to see if the date of record on a land deed might provide further clues.

### Notes for JEREMIAH CROWSON:

An LDS file places Jeremiah, born 1823, as a son of Abraham Crowson, of Giles Co., Tenn., who was a brother of West Crowson. They both moved into Wear's Cove, Sevier County. Persons researching this family as a direct line might look in that direction.

### Endnotes

1. *1850 U.S. Federal Census, Murray Co., Georgia*, (M432-78), p.241, Ann and Jeremiah are living next to William Hedrick (son of Jacob), who is, in turn, next to Jacob and Polly Hedrick [sic]. Jeremiah Crowson signs an 1866 deed as an heir to the land of Jacob and Polly Hedrick. Crowson's relationship to the Headricks is not stated in the deed; however, as an heir, he is presumably a son-in-law. Ann, his wife in 1850, is of the age to be a daughter of Jacob and Polly Headrick. Ann apparently married before 1850 and does not appear by name in her father's household. Based on the evidence I have placed her into the household of Jacob and Polly Headrick, with a little room for error.
2. Oregon State Board of Health, *Death Certificate of Jacob P. Crowson*, Cert. no. 3174, Ann Headrick of Tennessee is given as the mother of Jacob P. Crowson, deceased.
3. Pritchett, Deborah Kaye (author), Ann (Headrick) Crowson is documented in census in 1870 in Murray County. The old Headrick homestead was divided up in 1866 (but not recorded until 1870). Jeremiah signed the deed--presumably in 1866, but possibly at the recording of the deed in 1870. Check deed and see notes on Ann Headrick.

11. *Murray County, Georgia: County Court Minutes, 1866-1868*, (RHS 4082), Jeremiah Crowson is drawn as grand juror number 11, chosen to serve in county court, the next session of which was scheduled to be held on the second Monday in "June next--1866." Eighteen jurors were selected. However, the minutes of the June 1866 term show only seventeen jurors who were called and sworn in. Jeremiah Crowson's name does not appear on that list. No explanation is given for his absence, so there is no way of knowing whether he was never called, was called and failed to appear, or appeared, but was inadvertently left off of the list.
